Minutes of the Meeting

15 October 2014

The Cripple Creek repeater is off the air right now.

There was a discussion on voice loudness with various operators, and using narrow band versus wide band transmitters.

The Simulated Emergency Test for the state of Colorado and Wyoming is coming up. Mike Brian and Dean Buckhouse will be operating from the Cripple Creek EOC.

We had a discussion on the National Traffic System and on ARES. It was noted that following the SET in Cripple Creek, Mike and Dean may go to Tenderfoot to check on the repeater.

Dean Buckhouse plans to talk with the county about moving that repeater to the new building on Tenderfoot. We are alone in the old building, and the new building has a better infrastructure and more security.

On October 23rd, the IEEE plans a guest speaker on 802.11 Intra-Vehicle Communications, at Colorado Technical.

As a way to increase meeting attendance, it was suggested that we raffle a "cheap HT" at the meeting. Another suggestion was to open a meeting to the Boy Scouts.
