## Net Control Script

[NET CONTROL STATIONS, BE SURE TO ID EVERY 10 MINUTES!!]

Good evening and welcome to the Mountain Amateur Radio Club's Tuesday Night Net. This is [CALLSIGN], [NAME] in [CITY], Net Control for this evening.

The purpose of this net is to provide a forum for Mountain Amateur Radio Club members, to communicate club information and communicate information of interest to the amateur radio community. This is a directed net, open to all licensed amateurs regardless of club affiliation and we encourage everyone to check-in and participate.

Any stations with emergency or priority traffic during the course of this net should break for net control. Is there any emergency or priority traffic at this time?

Are there any mobile or short-term stations who would like to be logged IN-AND-OUT ONLY this evening?

Next we will take announcements and reports. After that we will ask for check-ins from any licensed amateur station.

First we will take announcements, reports and comments from MARC Officers and Board Members. Do we have any Mountain Amateur Radio Club officers or board members with any reports, announcements or comments?

Our next report section is reserved for any official announcements from Teller County Office of Emergency Management or Teller County government on topics such as emergencies, fire bans, etc. Do we have a representative from Teller County with any announcements or reports?

[CHECK-IN, TAKE REPORTS & ANNOUNCEMENTS, THANK]

Next, do we have any other stations with any additional business or announcements for the net?

[CHECK-IN, TAKE REPORTS & ANNOUNCEMENTS, THANK]

Our Tuesday Night Net takes place on the linked repeater system courtesy of the Mountain Amateur Radio Club. Is there anybody on frequency who would like additional information about the Mountain Amateur Radio Club?

[REFER MARC INFO INQUIRIES TO BILL KCØFNV OR DEAN KBØVVA. IF DEAN OR BILL ARE NOT ON THE NET, OBTAIN CONTACT INFO FROM THE STATION AND SEND IT TO DEAN OR BILL]

We will now begin our regular check-ins from any licensed amateur station. We will ask for your station information and then after we have checked everyone in we'll go to the top of the list and ask each station for any comments they would like to share with the net. When you check in, please give your CALL SIGN, NAME and LOCATION slowly. International phonetics are appreciated on your call sign:

Stations with call sign suffixes ALPHA through HOTEL, please call now:

Next, call sign suffixes INDIA through QUEBEC, please call:

Next, call sign suffixes ROMEO through ZULU, please call:

Finally, any stations ALPHA through ZULU, please call:

Thank you all for checking in tonight. Let's go back through the list and ask everyone for their comments.

[RUN LIST FOR COMMENTS. CHECK WITH OFFICERS FOR ANY ADDITIONAL COMMENTS.]

Now that everyone has had an opportunity to provide comments, we will take check-ins from any other stations who would like to participate in the net. Re-checks are also welcome.

Thank you all for checking in tonight. Let's go back through the list and ask everyone for their comments.

[RUN LIST FOR COMMENTS]

[REPEAT THE PROCESS UNTIL NO ONE RESPONDS]

I would like to thank everyone for checking in tonight, and hope you continue to do so on a regular basis. We also thank the Mountain Amateur Radio Club for the use of this repeater system. This is [CALL SIGN] closing the Tuesday Night Net and returning the system to normal amateur use at [TIME]. Have a great week! [CALL SIGN]

## Notes for Net Control Stations

Net Manager: Greg Liverman, K0MGL, 719.689.0787, [liverman@att.net](mailto:liverman@att.net)

Start the net precisely at 7:30 pm.

Net Control Identification: Part 97, FCC Rules & Regulations state that stations identify at least once every 10 minutes. It is very easy, as Net Control, to forget to do this. I watch my clock and identify on the even 10 minutes: Net starts at 7:30, identify at 7:40, 7:50, 8:00, 8:10, etc. "This is [CALLSIGN], Net Control for the Tuesday Night Net."

Be sure to leave about 3 seconds between exchanges to allow time for stations to break with comments, questions, or for emergency traffic. Avoid the urge to "quick key" your responses.

Most importantly, keep in mind that as Net Control you are the one in charge. Our net is generally very laid back and relaxed, so enjoy yourself, have fun and let your personality show through.

### Net Reports

Please send the following information to the Net Manager as soon as possible after the Net in the following format: TNN Report, [DATE: MM/DD/YY], [CALLSIGN] NCS, [#] check-ins (including yourself), [#] minutes (duration of the net). It is no longer necessary to itemize the individual stations that checked in, unless you want to do so. Net reports can be delivered by E-mail, phone or radio. Email is preferred. Here is a sample net report from a net on 10/17/00:
